Deep Roots works with children, who are disconnected through homelessness and provides transitional and emergency shelter to families in need. By providing transportation, you will provide families with access to services they desperately need to get back on their feet and give children the opportunity to participate in extracurricular and educational activities. We provide transportation to our residents here at Clairvaux Farm as well as transportation to and from monthly events for children who are or who have been homeless in Cecil County and Delaware.

We will provide an orientation and training session to familiarize you with Deep Roots and the duties of the transportation volunteer.

Duties:

There are several different transportation opportunities. We provide a van for the van runs and for transporting multiple children to and from the Widening the Horizon Monthly Events Program. If you are interested, let us know the dates and time frames you have available.

- Be punctual and dependable after signing up for a shift.

- Van Runs: 8 a.m. - 12 p.m. and 1 p.m. - 4 p.m. (Tuesday & Thursday) & a Saturday Van Run
- Monthly Events: Saturday transportation to take kids to/from events
- Daily Transportation: Take residents to appointments, 12 step meetings, kids to practices, etc.

Cecil County and Delaware transportation needs

- Monthly Events: Saturday transportation to take kids to/from events
