



Tutor and Mentor

Deep Roots is a nonprofit that works with children, who are disconnected through homelessness, and provides transitional and emergency shelter to families in need. We are looking for individuals willing to mentor (including tutoring students). We are flexible with your schedule and availability.

Duties:

- Participate in one-on-one mentoring with students.
- Communicate regularly with the student, parents, as well as volunteer coordinator.
- Communicate with the parents in order to schedule sessions. (Ideally once a week for tutoring sessions, or one to two times a month for mentoring sessions.)
- Be a positive role model.
- Provide encouragement and inclusiveness.

Qualifications:

- Age: 21+
- Reliable transportation.
- Pass criminal background check, provided free of charge.
- Must have time available in their schedule for the required amount of sessions each month.
- Must be committed to serving for at least one year with Deep Roots and understand they need to be reliable for the children they work with.
- If as a Mentor you choose to take the child off-site (upon approval by parents and Deep Roots), you must first pass a Driver's Check.

Benefits:

- Reference or letter of recommendation provided upon request.
- Meet new people and gain new experiences.
- Enriching the lives of children.
